Sustainability generally refers to the adoption and application of environmentally responsible practices, sound social policies and exceptional governance structures to minimise risks and volatility and to enhance the long-term development impact of corporate activities. Sustainability in business, therefore means managing a company in a way that takes into account the social, economic and environmental aspects that can be referred to as the "triple bottom line" or "People, Planet, Profit". Sustainability is about obtaining a good balance of these three aspects.
